House Passes Comprehensive Ban on Federal Abortion Funding



A new pro-life bill to permanently prohibit federal funding of abortion was passed by the House of Representatives in a 251-175 vote on May 4th. The bill, the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act (H.R. 3), was sponsored by Reps. Chris Smith (R-NJ) and Dan Lipinski (D-II.). It was supported by 235 Republicans and 16 Democrats, while 175 Democrats opposed it.

The White House issued a veto threat on the bill shortly before the House voted to pass it.

"There are over one million Americans who are alive today because of the Hyde Amendment policy – but President Obama, although he claims to seek abortion reduction, continues to work against that policy," said NRLC Legislative Director Douglas Johnson. "The White House veto threat demonstrates yet again that President Obama is determined to expand federal subsidies for abortion on demand – despite his verbal smokescreens. The 175 House Democrats who voted against the bill will be firmly marked as supporters of federal subsidies for elective abortion."

On Mother's Day, Rep. Nancy Pelosi (D-Ca.), the former Speaker of the House, sent an email urgently requesting \$50,000 to combat this pro-life bill. She wrote,

"This week, Republicans voted unanimously on an extremist anti-choice bill that would deny millions of women access to reproductive health care."

For many years, federal funding of abortion has been limited by a patchwork of laws – many of which expire annually, because they are incorporated into annual appropriations bills. The best known is the Hyde Amendment, but this law applies only to funds that flow through the annual Health and Human Services appropriations bill, and it expires annually. The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) ("Obamacare"), enacted in 2010, opened new pipelines for federal funding of abortion, which are not governed by the Hyde Amendment or any other statutory law. H.R. 3 would codify the principles of the Hyde Amendment on a permanent, government-wide basis, applicable to both longstanding federal health programs and to the new programs created by the PPACA.

Following the House approval of H.R. 3, identical legislation was introduced by pro-life Sen. Roger Wicker (R-Ms.) as S. 906. "Every time we've attempted to advance the pro-life cause through legislation it has always started out as an uphill battle," Wicker said. "It's unlikely that we'll be able to get to 60 votes [in the current Senate]. But that doesn't mean we shouldn't try. Americans overwhelmingly agree that tax dollars should not be used to support abortion providers. I will continue to advocate legislation that honors and protects human life."

Obama Attends Dinner with Planned Parenthood President

After his May 10th campaign speech in El Paso, Texas, President Barack Obama attended a fundraising dinner with Planned Parenthood president Cecile Richards. According to the Austin Statesman, more than 50 wealthy Democrats paid \$35,800 per person and over \$50,000 per couple to attend. Although the guests attending the event were not announced, after the event Cecile Richards excitedly tweeted, "Dinner with President Obama in my home town! Doesn't get much [sic] better than that."

President Obama has a long history of working with Planned Parenthood. In a 2007 campaign address to Planned Parenthood, then Senator Obama was received with thunderous applause and cheering. He said, "On the issue of choice... I will not yield and Planned Parenthood will not yield." Mr. Obama also promised, "The first thing that

I would do as president is sign the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA). That's the first thing I would do." This act would nullify any state or federal law that would prevent access to abortion. More recently, Planned Parenthood has been an adamant supporter of Obamacare, which promises to increase significantly the federal funds received by Planned Parenthood.

Carol Tobias Elected New National Right to Life President

Becomes the organization's 9th president since Roe v. Wade

On Saturday, April 9th, Carol Tobias was elected president of the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC), the national federation of 50 state affiliates and more than 3,000 local chapters. Tobias, who becomes the 9th NRLC president since Roe v. Wade, succeeds Wanda Franz, Ph.D. of West Virginia.

"I am extremely humbled and honored to be elected president by

the National Right to Life board, which represents our nationwide network of state affiliates and local chapters," said Mrs. Tobias. "As the late pro-life Congressman Henry Hyde of Illinois said, National Right to Life 'is the flagship of the pro-life movement." I'm looking forward to the opportunity to help our pro-life network in its continuing

effort to educate the public and pass laws protecting mothers and their unborn children."

A native of North Dakota, Tobias has served on the NRLC board of directors since 1987. From 1983 to 1991 she was executive director of North Dakota Right to Life and in 1991 was hired as NRLC Political Director, a position she held until 2005. During her tenure as NRLC political director, pro-life majorities were elected to both the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate. In both 2000 and 2004, she oversaw the efforts of NRLC's Political Action Committee on behalf of George W. Bush.

"The pro-life movement is the greatest social cause of our time," added Tobias. "I am eager to continue National Right to Life's educational, legislative, and political efforts to advance the right to life of the most vulnerable members of our human family – the unborn, the elderly, and the medically dependent and disabled.

New Hungary Constitution Defends the Unborn

Amid many threats to life in Europe, Hungary adopted a new constitution in April which protects every person from the moment of conception. The new constitution was voted into effect on Easter Monday by a newly elected party majority which earned it the name 'The Easter Constitution.'

Under the section entitled "Freedom and Responsibility," the new constitution says, "Human dignity is inviolable. Everyone has the right to life and human dignity; the life of a fetus will be protected from conception."

However, various European organizations and "human rights defenders" decry this renewed defense of vulnerable life. Amnesty International is among these opponents and objects that Hungary's new constitution "violates international and European human rights standards."

The Hungarian government has subsequently launched a new ad campaign which advocates adoption and reminds citizens that every baby has the right to life. The new ads feature a graphic of a baby in utero which says, "I understand if you aren't ready for me... but rather put me up for adoption, LET ME LIVE!" The government hopes that these

ads will help reduce abortions in Hungary and re-establish respect for life at all stages.

U.S. House Says No to Planned Parenthood Funding in 2011, but U.S. Senate Says Yes

The U.S. Senate has voted to continue federally funding Planned Parenthood through the end of the fiscal year, despite opposition from many pro-life and religious groups, including National Right to Life and the U.S. Catholic bishops.

Pro-life lawmakers argued that Planned Parenthood should not continue to receive taxpayer money. In 2009 Planned Parenthood received more than \$363 million from all levels of government, and performed 332,278 abortions, making it the nation's largest abortion provider.

On April 14, 2011, the U.S. House of Representatives voted 241-185 to pass H. Con. Res 36, which would have excluded Planned Parenthood from receiving federal funds for the remaining fiscal year. However, the Senate subsequently defeated the measure on a 58-42 vote. The vote was largely along party lines, with 42 Republicans voting to end Planned Parenthood funding, while all 53 Democrats together with 5 Republicans voted to continue funding. The failure of this resolution ensures that Planned Parenthood will continue to receive millions of taxpayer dollars for abortions through the fiscal year.

In an April 13 letter to Congress, Cardinal Daniel

DiNardo, the chairman of the Committee on Pro-Life Activities of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, urged members of Congress to vote yes on the bill.

He wrote, "Congress will have to make decisions whether to cut programs that everyone agrees are beneficial... Whether to fund the largest abortion network in the country is not one of those hard choices."

Some groups argue that unless Planned Parenthood receives federal funding, many low-income women will not receive the care they need. Cardinal DiNardo responded, "To the extent that Planned Parenthood does provide any legitimate health services for women, however, those services can be provided by others... therefore the question at issue here is: When low-income women need these legitimate health care services, should the federal government insist that they receive them from the local abortion provider?"
