Abortion on Demand

There have been 61 million abortions since the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision legalized abortion on demand.

Roger Marshall is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand and supports protection for unborn children. As a pro-life OB/GYN, Roger Marshall knows the value of each human life and has an exemplary record showing his leadership on the issue. Barbara Bollier supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason. As a state senator, Barbara Bollier is an outspoken opponent of pro-life legislation in Kansas.

Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act

The *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* would protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, a point by which the unborn child is capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Roger Marshall co-sponsored and voted for the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act in Congress.

Barbara Bollier voted against Kansas's Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act in the state Senate.

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

Prohibiting taxpayer funding of abortion saves lives.

Roger Marshall voted against using our tax dollars for abortion. He also opposes taxpayer funding of abortion providers. Barbara Bollier voted to allow using tax dollars for abortion. She also supports taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Judicial Nominations to the US Supreme Court

The fundamental documents of American democracy and freedom, the Constitution and the Declaration of Indepencence, have given us essential principles to be respected by the courts such as the "unalienable" right to life. The next president may have the opportunity to appoint one to three justices to the U.S. Supreme Court.

Roger Marshall supports confirmation to the U.S. Supreme Court of well-qualified persons who will interpret the Constitution according to its text, such as Neil Gorsuch and Brett Kavanaugh, who voted this year to uphold Louisiana's pro-life law. EMILY's List, a pro-abortion PAC which is focused on securing a pro-abortion Supreme Court, is investing large sums of money to elect Barbara Bollier.
