Abortion

Terri Lynn Land is pro-life. She opposes abortion on demand, and supports legal protection for unborn children.

Terri Lynn Land supports the bill to protect unborn children from abortion after 20 weeks, when they are capable of experiencing excruciating pain during abortions.

Terri Lynn Land will not vote to weaken existing prolife laws if she is elected.

Gary Peters supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason. He voted against a bill to prohibit the use of abortion solely as a method of sex selection (5/31/12, Roll Call No. 299).

Gary Peters voted against the bill to protect unborn children from abortion after 20 weeks, when they are capable of experiencing excruciating pain during abortions (6/18/13, Roll Call No. 251).

Gary Peters is a co-sponsor of H.R. 3471, a bill that, if enacted, would invalidate nearly all state and federal limitations on abortion.

Obamacare Health Care Law

Terri Lynn Land opposes the pro-abortion, prorationing Obamacare law, and she is committed to help reverse the abortion-expanding and rationing effects of the law.

Gary Peters voted for Obamacare, which provides government funding for insurance plans that pay for abortion on demand, and will lead to the rationing of lifesaving medical treatments.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Terri Lynn Land opposes using tax dollars to pay for abortion.

Gary Peters voted to allow tax dollars to pay for abortion (1/28/14, Roll Call No. 30).
