Abortion on Demand

There have been 61 million abortions since the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision legalized abortion on demand.

Ann Wagner is pro-life. She opposes abortion on demand and supports protection for unborn children. Jill Schupp supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason. As a state senator, Jill Schupp led the fights against every pro-life bill.

Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act

The *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* would protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, a point by which the unborn child is capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Ann Wagner co-sponsored and voted for the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act in Congress.

Jill Schupp voted in the state Senate against legislation to protect unborn children after 20 weeks.

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

Prohibiting taxpayer funding of abortion saves lives.

Ann Wagner voted against using our tax dollars for abortion. She also opposes taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Jill Schupp supports using tax dollars for abortion. She also supports taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Parental Notice Before Abortion

Studies show the positive impact parental involvement laws have in significantly reducing the rates of abortion among minors.

Ann Wagner supports legislation requiring parental notice before an abortion is performed on a minor daughter.

Jill Schupp voted against a bill to strengthen parental notice before an abortion is performed on a minor daughter in Missouri.
