Abortion on Demand

Dan Bishop is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Dan Bishop supports the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, legislation to protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, when the unborn child can feel pain. Dan McCready supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act

As a state Senator, Dan Bishop voted for North Carolina's Born-Alive bill that would provide medical care to a baby who survives an abortion.

Dan McCready opposes requiring care for babies who survive abortions.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Dan Bishop opposes using your tax dollars to pay for abortion on demand.

Dan McCready supports taxpayer funding of abortion on demand.

Government Funding for Abortion Providers

Dan Bishop opposes taxpayer funding of abortion providers.
