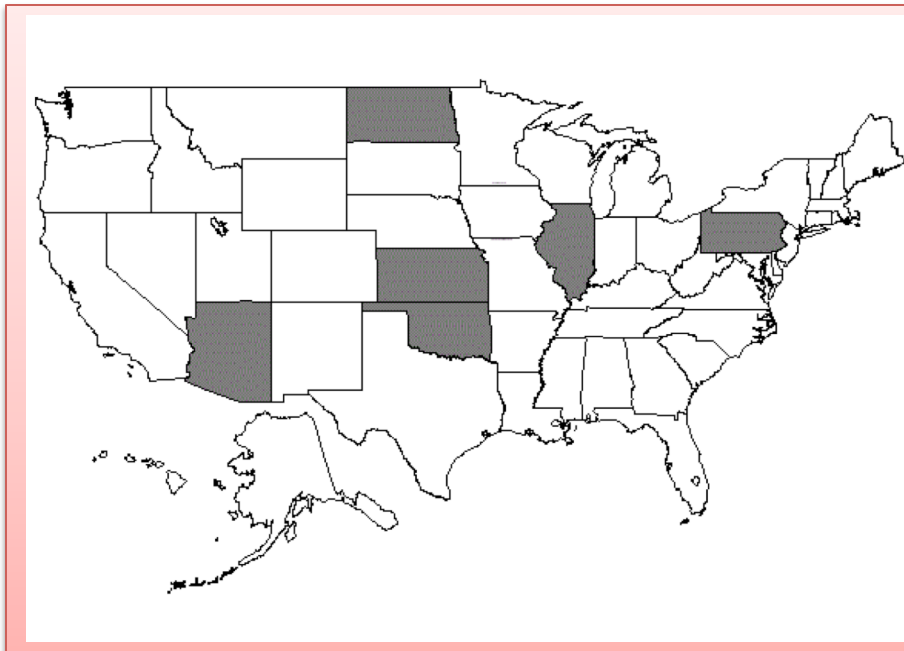


State Laws on Sex-Selection Abortion Bans

These laws protect unborn babies from being aborted on account of their sex. Sex Selection Abortion is a form of prenatal discrimination that wages a war typically on unborn baby girls. In April 2013, a poll taken by The Polling Company found that 85% of respondents supported banning sex selection abortions. Currently six (6) states have enacted laws protecting unborn children who would be aborted solely because of their gender.
