

## **ULTRASOUND LAWS**

January, 2013

Following, are the 24 states that have some type of Ultrasound Viewing Law.

Four states require that an ultrasound be performed prior to an abortion. The screen be displayed so the mother can view it and a description of the image of the unborn child must be given. They are Louisiana, North Carolina\*, Oklahoma\*\*, and Texas.

Six states require that an ultrasound be performed and that the mother be offered the opportunity to view the ultrasound. They are Alabama, Arizona, Florida, Kansas, Mississippi and Virginia.

Nine states require that the mother be provided with an opportunity to view an ultrasound if ultrasound is used as part of the abortion process. They are Arkansas, Georgia, Idaho, Michigan, Nebraska, Ohio, South Carolina, Utah and West Virginia.

Five states require that the mother be provided with the opportunity to view an ultrasound. They are Indiana, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota and Utah.
