# Glenn Youngkin Terry McAuliffe

### **Abortion on Demand**

There have been 63 million abortions since the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision legalized abortion on demand.

**Glenn Youngkin** is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Terry McAuliffe supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

**Terry McAuliffe** is supported by the nation's largest chain of abortion clinics.

# **Taxpayer Funding of Abortion**

Prohibiting taxpayer funding of abortion saves lives.

**Glenn Youngkin** opposes using our tax dollars for abortion. He also opposes taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Terry McAuliffe supports using our tax dollars for abortion. As Governor, he vetoed a bill that would have prevented taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

### Late Abortions

By 20 weeks, unborn children are capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Glenn Youngkin: "We got to stop allowing abortions all the way up until the last week before birth." (7/21)

**Glenn Youngkin** supports legislation to protect unborn children who can feel pain from late abortions

**Terry McAuliffe** supported legislation that would have allowed abortions for any reason and at any point during pregnancy.

Terry McAuliffe threatened to veto a bill that would have protected unborn babies at 20 weeks, when they are capable of feeling pain.
