Abortion on Demand

There have been 63 million abortions since the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* Supreme Court decision legalized abortion on demand.

Glenn Youngkin is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Glenn Youngkin: "I am staunchly, unabashedly pro-life." (7/21)

Terry McAuliffe supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

Terry McAuliffe is supported by the nation's largest chain of abortion clinics.

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

Prohibiting taxpayer funding of abortion saves lives.

Glenn Youngkin opposes using our tax dollars for abortion. He also opposes taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Terry McAuliffe supports using our tax dollars for abortion. As Governor, he vetoed a bill that would have prevented taxpayer funding of abortion providers.

Late Abortions

By 20 weeks, unborn children are capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Glenn Youngkin: "We got to stop allowing abortions all the way up until the last week before birth." (7/21)

Glenn Youngkin supports legislation to protect unborn children who can feel pain from late abortions.

Terry McAuliffe supported legislation that would have allowed abortions for any reason and at any point during pregnancy.

Terry McAuliffe threatened to veto a bill that would have protected unborn babies at 20 weeks, when they are capable of feeling pain.
